Co-Ed Pinewood Derby Rules and Regulations

Please read carefully and distribute to participants:

- * Cars from previous years cannot be used again.
- * Any girl or boy in grades 1 through 6 may participate.
- * Cars cannot weigh more than 5 ounces - Race day scales are official.
- * Cars cannot be handled by anyone after the final weigh-in.
- * Weights can be added (or subtracted) on the day of the race before final weigh-in.
-Bring weights with you!
- * If judges disagree about a race result, the race will be ran again.
- * The decisions of the judges are final!
- * The cost of each kit is \$6.00 and kits are available at the Thousand Hills Baptist Association.
-Kits must be paid for when they are received.
- * The girl or boy who made the car must be present to race.
- * All cars must be inspected before being raced.
- * Axles, etc. cannot be altered - placings of wood cannot be changed.
- * No parts (WHEELS OR AXLES) may be substituted.
- * Dry graphite will be available the day of the race.
- * Only dry lubricants are allowed.
- * Participants can only win in one category.

Outlaw Derby Rules and Regulations

Please read carefully and distribute to participants:

- * This race is open to everyone not eligible for the Co-Ed Derby.
- * Cars cannot weigh more than 7 ounces - Race day scales are official.
- * Cars cannot be handled by anyone after the final weigh-in.
- * Weights can be added (or subtracted) on the day of the race before final weigh-in.
-Bring weights with you!
- * If judges disagree about a race result, the race will be ran again.
- * The decisions of the judges are final!
- * The cost of each kit is \$6.00 and kits are available at the Thousand Hills Baptist Association.
-Kits must be paid for when they are received.
- * The person who made the car must be present to race.
- * All cars must be inspected before being raced.
- * Axles, etc. can be altered - placings of wood can be changed.
- * Parts may be substituted - nails are allowed.
- * Graphite will be available on the day of the race.
- * Participants can only win in one category.
